Enclosed you will find Permit No. 26-13 for the AAA Hauling of NC, Inc., Transfer, Recycle, Resource Recovery and Processing Facility, the permit is dated July 28, 2010. The following are important items that remain to be accomplished;

- Read your permit carefully, it is important that you understand your permit. If you have any questions regarding the process or the permit please contact me immediately.
- Enclosed are the approved documents related to your permit. It is important for you to understand that the permit and these documents are equally important to the permitted operation of the facility.
- Enclosed is a certified original of your permit. It is important that the certified original permit be recorded by the Register of Deeds in Cumberland County. It should be indexed in the grantor index under the name of the land owner. The certified original should be affixed with the Register's seal, date, book number and page number of recording. The certified original of the permit with the Register's information affixed should then be returned to me at the address at the bottom of this page. The purpose of this recordation to notify future buyers that a solid waste management facility existed on the property, in accordance with North Carolina General Statutes.
- You established with estimates, that you provided; that you planned on processing 25 tons of waste per day at the facility, that you will be operating the facility five (5) days per week, and that you estimate that a third party would charge \$150.00 per ton for the removal and proper disposal of stored materials, if needed. Therefore, a cost of **\$18,750.00** has been established and approved for the purpose of Financial Assurance. Mr. Donald Herndon or Ms. Shawn McKee, Division Compliance Officers, will be in contact with you in the near future to ensure that the appropriate Financial Assurance Mechanism is established by you for your permitted facility.
