

Revised Operating Procedures

Permit # 26-13

Hours Mon-Fri 7:30-5:00

Record Keeping

1. Record weight entering
2. Record weight leaving
3. Record inspected loads and take pictures if needed
4. Complete reports as needed

Trucks Entering

1. Once the truck enters the property they are to be weighed
2. Trucks are to proceed to the dumping area
3. Loads are to be spot checked for illegal contents
4. Back trucks onto dump pad
5. Trucks are to return to scales to be reweighed
6. Driver to stop at weigh master for paperwork

Trucks after dumping

1. Inspect load once it has been dumped
2. Notify driver of any banned items and have them remove them
3. Let office know company name and driver and item that was turned away
4. Sort and dispose in the proper containers

Sorting and Picking Line

1. Items will be fed via conveyor belt to picking station
2. Remove the various recyclables and place into the appropriate containers
3. Full containers will be removed and replaced with empty containers
4. Full containers are to be hauled to appropriate disposal sites

Leachate Collection


1. Use Speedy Dry material to absorb any liquids that collect on concrete pad.
2. Sweep up and dispose of material at Landfill

Concrete, Brick and Asphalt

1. All waste material, painted concrete and concrete with exposed rebar must be removed prior to stockpiling this material.
2. Painted and exposed rebar shall be placed in a container to be disposed of at the landfill.

Land Clearing Debris and Clean Wood

1. All waste, painted and treated lumber shall be removed prior to stockpiling this material
2. All waste, painted and treated lumber shall be placed in a container to be disposed of at the landfill.
