




The conditions contained in Solid Waste Rules Sections .0510 and .0566, specific closure conditions for this facility include:

1. The final cover of one foot of soil shall be maintained [.0566(5)]. Please note that any rutting or damage to the cover resulting from approved recycling and recovery operations must be repaired in a timely manner.
2. Permanent erosion control measures, if any, shall be maintained [.0566(6)];
3. Temporary seeding, covered with straw & tacking or similar material, if necessary, shall be provided to prevent erosion [.0566(6)];
4. Vegetation consisting of native grasses or combination of grasses to promote a year round vegetative cover shall be maintained [.0566(7)];
5. Drainage control measures shall be implemented as part of site maintenance as necessary to prevent the impoundment of surface water over disposal areas or the infiltration of surface water into the waste at the facility [.0566(10)];
6. The concentration of explosive gases generated by the facility shall not exceed 25% of the lower explosive limit for the gases in facility structures, or the lower explosive limit for the gases at the property boundary [.0566(13)].
7. Leachate shall be controlled and contained on-site through the use of best management practices [.0566(14)].
