Don and Stacey – I've reviewed the response to comments dated Jan. 21 (Doc ID 12782) and I have just a few of comments:

1. The guidance that was added as Appendix C to the Operations Manual is not the guidance referenced in text. See Section 1.12.7 of the Operations Manual.
2. Asphalt shingles should be stored in a container, or on a impervious surface with run-on/run-off controls.
3. Appendix I – Please add the letter dated December 30, 2008 from DOT to the beginning of the appendix.

As you requested, the composting and wood waste processing part of the application is being separated from this permit action, and a permit condition will acknowledge that the composting and wood waste processing portion of the application is not approved at this time. This will allow the transfer station portion of the facility to be permitted without waiting for the composting part of the application to be completed. The Composting and Land Application Branch will continue to review the composting application, and there will be a separate permit fee.
