Dear Mr. Newbern, and Mr. and Mrs. Newbern:

Please find enclosed the Permit to Construct and Operate for the Soundside C&D Waste Transfer & Recycling Center, Permit No. 27-05T-Tranfer-2011. This permit issuance approves the relocation and expansion of the C&D waste transfer station to the area east of the power lines on the same property.

In general, the new facility permit does not reiterate permit conditions which are included in the Solid Waste Management Rules, 15A NCAC 13B, nor does it restate specific conditions which are included within the approved plans, such as site specific operations.

Prior to operation of the facility in the new area, pre-operative conditions must be met, as listed in condition 3 on page 5 of the permit, including the submittal of the financial assurance mechanism. The approved financial assurance amount is \$162,525.

Please review the conditions of the permit carefully. Among the many permit conditions for the facility, we bring to your particular attention: condition 3 on page 3, which requires that the certified copy of the permit be recorded at the Register of Deeds within 30 days; and conditions 32 through 35 on page 14, concerning the continued operation of the existing facility until the new area has been constructed and approved for operation. Approval to operate the existing facility at its current location expires February 18, 2012 or when construction of the new facility site is complete and pre-operational approval of the area is granted, whichever is sooner.

Enclosed with this letter to Mr. Racy Newbern is the certified copy of the permit for recordation at the Register of Deeds.

The stamped approved Permit to Construct and Operate application will be available for printing from our website in a few days, Doc ID 12931:
