This permit approves the request to allow receipt of yard waste, mulch, and compost at the transfer station which will be transferred to the Brunswick Waste Management Facility, LLC Landfill located in Brunswick, Virginia. Please be advised that the disposal of yard waste collected at the transfer station in a North Carolina municipal solid waste landfill is prohibited.

Please be aware that issuance of the permit does not exempt an applicant from any local ordinances that may regulate a facility and the responsibility of compliance with any applicable ordinance lies with the permit holder.
