Re: Compliance with 15A NCAC 13B .0547 and Approval of the Permit Application for Continued Operations of a C&D on Top of a Closed MSW Landfill (the permit application), Edgecombe County Landfill Facility, Edgecombe County, North Carolina, Permit No. 33-01, Document ID No. (Doc ID) 9854

Dear Mr. Bagley:

The Division Waste Management (DWM), Solid Waste Section has determined that Edgecombe County C&DLF has met the continued operation requirements stated in Solid Waste Management Rule 15A NCAC 13B .0547(4). The DWM hereby approves the permit application (Doc ID 9206), which can be directly download from the DWM's web site at http://acp.ncdenr.org/pls/apex/f?p=2136:25:3544633445570057:::CIR:IR_PERMITID:3301-CDLF-1997.

Enclosed please find the Solid Waste Permit No. 33-01 – Permit to Operate for Phases 1 and 2, the final fact sheet, and the cover sheet with the approval seal and signature of the approved permit application. Please be aware of the GENERAL PERMIT CONDITION NO. 3; the original copy of the permit must be recorded in the Register of Deeds office and sent back to the Solid Waste Section to my attention. Please also remember that financial assurance must be kept current and updated annually to reflect changes in the Rules, operation of the sites, and inflation.

Edgecombe County has also requested to voluntarily conduct a landfill gas management program at the Edgecombe County Landfill via this permit application. The preliminary design of the landfill gas collection and control system (LFGCCS) was submitted as a portion of the permit application document for a review and approval. The DWM hereby also approves the conceptual design of the LFGCCS. However, Edgecombe County shall not construct the LFGCCS at the Edgecombe County Landfill until the final design of LFGCCS is submitted DWM for a review and approval. The final design of LFGCCS shall incorporate the responses to the DWM's comments, specifically COMMENT NOs. 3, 8, 10, and 16 on the system (Doc ID 8765) dated October 17, 2009. Edgecombe County must submit this final design plan as a

permit modification in accordance with applicable statutes and rules in effect on that date, and be subject to a permitting fee.
