Dear Mr. Glover:

The Solid Waste Section has reviewed your request dated September 23, 2011, to rescind the solid waste permit issued for the Barnhill Contracting Company – Rocky Mount Plant, Permit No. 33-04-TP-2011, to process recyclable tear-off asphalt shingles. We have also reviewed the Tear-off Shingle Recycling Notification that you provided for the facility.

The tear-off asphalt shingle can be classified as a recovered material in accordance with NCGS §130A-290 (a) (24) and §130A-306.05 (c), based on the information provided in the notification. A recovered material is not subject to regulation as a solid waste, as long as the requirements of the statute are met, and therefore, your facility does not require a solid waste permit. The Solid Waste Section hereby rescinds Permit No. 33-04-2011, as you requested.
