

Letter of Verification for LCID Fill Facility



Dear Mr. Barber,

This letter is to verify an existing LCID facility and apply for a repermit of the same site with additional phases of fill for future development. The following are the information requested by you on September 5, 2003:

1. Existing LCID Facility Information:

The site is currently located in the rear of the Barnhill Contracting Company property along NC 97 in Edgecombe County. The site is within the City of Rocky Mount jurisdiction. The property contains an existing and operating asphalt plant and a 33 +/- acre pond that is located between the LCID location and the road. There are two smaller ponds that are excavated pits that are located around the existing LCID landfill to help contain and clean sediment water. The site was permitted in October 1998 and expires in October 2003.

2. Permitted and Remaining Volume of Fill:

Based on the original maps produced for the landfill, the estimated volume of total fill for the site was approximately **220,000** cubic yards. Within the past five years, an estimated **69,097** cubic yards have been filled and utilized.

3. Proposed Volume of Fill:

The estimated volume of fill from Barnhill Contracting Company per year is between 10,000 to 14,000 cubic yards, which totals at the maximum range of 70,000 cubic yards for every 5-year period. The above estimate and the actual amount filled in the past 5 years were used to determine the future 3 phases of the project with the following breakdown:

- Phase I: 67,171 cubic yards
- Phase II: 71,341 cubic yards

- Phase III: 78,169 cubic yards

As you can see, the volume of fill slightly increased from phase to phase. We tried to account for continued growth in the area and the potential for increased amounts of volume within the next 10 to 15 years.


4. Site Design and Construction Plans for LCID Facility:

The construction plans for the LCID facility is enclosed with this letter of verification. The plans include the setbacks and meet the siting requirements of section .0564 of the Division of Solid Waste Management Regulations. The new flood maps for the area were used to determine the 100-year floodplain, which has been modified compared to the original submission for the site. The estimated 100-year floodplain is at elevation 77 and shown on the plans. No new fill is proposed within the 100-year floodplain as required by regulations.


As shown by the 400-scale map on the cover sheet of the plans, no new development has occurred within the ¼-mile radius surrounding the existing LCID facility within the past 5 years. However, another LCID facility has been permitted within ½-mile just to the north of this existing facility and is owned and operated by the City of Rocky Mount.





1. This permit is issued for a period not to exceed five years from date of issuance, 29 October 2003. This permit is for the construction and operation of the landfill(Cell 1) to a height of 90msl according to the approved plans, sheet CE-1. Any revisions of these approved plans must be approved by the North Carolina Solid Waste Section.
2. Amendments or revisions to the NC Solid Waste Management Rules or any violation of groundwater standards may necessitate modification of the approved plans or closure of the facility.
3. **This permit shall not be effective unless the certified copy is filed in the Register of Deeds office and indexed in the grantor index under the name of the owner of the land in the county or counties in which the land is located.** The certified copy of the permit, affixed with the Register's seal and the date, book, and page number of recording shall be returned to the Division of Solid Waste Management, within **THIRTY (30)** working days, from date received. 4. When this property is sold, leased, conveyed, or transferred, the deed or other instrument of transfer shall contain in the deed description section in no smaller type than that used in the body of the deed or instrument a statement that the property has been used as a land clearing and inert debris landfill.
5. This facility is permitted to receive land clearing waste, yard trash, untreated and unpainted wood, and inert debris such as rock, brick, concrete, concrete block, and uncontaminated soil. Waste acceptance requirements may be affected by future revisions and amendments to the NC General Statutes, or to the NC Solid Waste Management Rules.
6. Waste shall be placed a minimum of four (4) feet above the seasonal high water table.
7. This facility shall conform to the operational requirements of the NC Solid Waste Management Rules, 15A NCAC 13B .0566, and to the operational plan required by 15A NCAC 13B .0565(4) prepared by Hobbs, Upchurch & Associates, P.A.

 - b. A sign shall be posted at the entrance as required by the NC Solid Waste Management Rules Operational Requirements, 15A NCAC 13B .0566 (16).
 - c. A certification letter, from a Registered Professional Engineer(Design Engineer typically), shall be submitted to the Section stating that the facility has been constructed in accordance with the approved plans.
 - d. Survey stakes/flags shall be installed to delineate the 100 year flood fringe on the south side of the cell and all test pits/holes used to estimate the seasonal high water table shall be backfilled prior to LCID waste placement.
10. Ground water quality at this facility is subject to the classification and remedial action provisions of 15 NCAC 2L.
11. An approved sedimentation and erosion control plan shall be obtained prior to the beginning of earth disturbing activities and all such activities shall be conducted in accordance with the Sedimentation Pollution Control Act of 1973 (15 NCAC 4) along with any other state, federal or local requirements.
12. Excavation, within the footprint of the disposal area(CELL 1), at this facility is not required by the approved plans. Any and all earth work shall be in accordance with the approved plan.
13. Open burning of land clearing waste is **PROHIBITED**.

 - d. Survey stakes/flags shall be installed to delineate the 100 year flood fringe on the south side of the cell and all test pits/holes used to estimate the seasonal high water table shall be backfilled prior to LCID waste placement.
10. Ground water quality at this facility is subject to the classification and remedial action provisions of 15 NCAC 2L.
11. An approved sedimentation and erosion control plan shall be obtained prior to the beginning of earth disturbing activities and all such activities shall be conducted in accordance with the Sedimentation Pollution Control Act of 1973 (15 NCAC 4) along with any other state, federal or local requirements.
12. Excavation, within the footprint of the disposal area (CELL 1), at this facility is not required by the approved plans. Any and all earth work shall be in accordance with the approved plan.
13. Open burning of land clearing waste is **PROHIBITED**.


