We appreciate your cooperation in allowing ERM to sample your water supply wells earlier this year. In a letter dated October 27, 2009, ERM provided you with updated information regarding the results of this sampling.

On October 30, 2009, ERM submitted a report to the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources (NCDENR) summarizing the findings of the site assessment activities conducted between July and September 2009.

As part of this activity, ERM sampled your water supply wells in addition to other wells in the area. ERM noted that no significant concentrations of the primary constituents associated with the Edwards Road Landfill, i.e. sulfates or manganese, were detected in any of the water supply well samples collected in the vicinity. Though there were some lead detections in your residential well water samples earlier this year, ERM reported that they were a result of a localized condition and were not related to the landfill.

Based on these findings, R.J. Reynolds Tobacco Company will conclude bottled water service to you on January 15, 2010. A representative of Le Bleu will contact you to schedule pickup of any remaining equipment or containers.
