On December 15, 2010, a pre-operational meeting was held at the Abbey Green Recycling Center in Forsyth County, the purpose of the meeting was to ensure the Facility was prepared to begin operations, in accordance with the Permit to Construct. In attendance were you, Mr. Jim Bryan, Mr. Steve Gomes, Mr. Jason Watkins and me. The Facility's as-built drawings, plans, and procedures were reviewed; a tour of the facility was conducted, as well. There were issues with the Facility that remain to be put in place, such as;

- The replacement of a missing tarp over the picking line loading area, where temporary measures for leachate collection are in place.
- The organization of the LCID Landfill area, which will be required, to utilize the space as an inert debris storage area.

The Division expects you will have these issues resolved in the coming days. Furthermore, on December 16, 2010 your Financial Assurance mechanism was received by the Division, the information has been reviewed and has been deemed acceptable.
