The Solid Waste Section has reviewed your request of June 21, 2011 (DIN 14244) to allow the Franklin County Transfer Station, Permit No. 35-03T, to receive waste from Vance and Granville Counties while Waste Industries is performing major repairs at their Vance County Transfer Station, Permit No. 91-02T. It stated that the repairs would require approximately three weeks to complete and begin the first week in July. An estimated 150-200 tons would be diverted to the Franklin County Transfer Station during the three-week period.
