Dear Mr. Wyrick:

An additional financial assurance requirement was enacted in The Solid Waste Management Act of 2007, NCGS 130A-295.2(h). It requires the owner of a sanitary landfill to establish financial assurance sufficient to cover a minimum of three million dollars (\$3,000,000) in costs for potential assessment and corrective action at the facility. This is in addition to closure and post-closure financial assurance. This requirement is effective at the first permit renewal after August 2009.

Costs for any ongoing corrective action and costs related to post-closure groundwater monitoring, landfill gas monitoring, and maintenance of the monitoring system may be placed under the assessment and corrective action category.

Based on the estimate provided in the application (DIN 13404) and reallocating the post-closure monitoring costs, the financial assurance breakdown for the landfill (all cells) is as follows:

Assessment & Correction Action	2,613,000	3,000,000

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Please ask the finance director for the City of Greensboro, to update the local government test for required financial assurance as stated in the table and sent to Donald Herndon of the Solid Waste Section. This must be done prior to issuing the permit.
