Dear Mr. Smith:

A 5-yr amendment application for a Permit to Construct (PTC) the WCA of High Point Construction and Demolition Landfill (C&DLF) - Phase 2 was submitted to the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) on your behalf by Charles Hiner of Golder Associates. The Section has determined that the application is incomplete because it does not meet the current permit conditions.

The current Permit to Operate is for the operation of the C&DLF and the C&D Waste Reclamation Pad. That permit expires on February 10, 2009, and an application for a permit amendment must be submitted by October 10, 2008, as noted in the general conditions of the permit. The operation plan that was submitted with the PTC application only includes the operation of the C&DLF. You may submit a revised operation plan for the PTC application that includes the Reclamation Pad operation. The revised operation plan would need to be reviewed prior to issuing the PTC, so a prompt response is needed. Otherwise, you will need to submit an additional permit modification application for the continued operation of the Reclamation Pad and incur an additional permit modification fee.
