Dear Mr. Friddle:

Under the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Rules, Permits to Operate are issued in 5-year increments. Solid Waste Section records indicate that the Permit to Operate for the above referenced facility is past due for the next 5-year permit period.

The following information must be submitted to the Section by September 22, 2010 in order to maintain continuous operation of the LCID landfill.

1. A minimum of two cross-sections along each major axis per operational area that shows the current elevations, the proposed excavation, the proposed elevation at the end of the 5-year phase of operation and the proposed final elevations. The excavation drawing must show the separation to groundwater and bedrock is at least 4 feet.
2. An updated Operations Plan.
3. A completed request for Compliance History Review (attached).
4. Letter from local government stating that the LCID complies with local land use and zoning ordinances.
5. Application fee of \$500 for 5-year permit.

Enclosed are application guidance and a copy of the LCID rules, which also include the requirements for closing your LCID landfill if operation of the facility has discontinued.

Please be aware that you must respond to this letter by the above date to maintain compliance with the NC Solid Waste Management Rules.
