Dear Mr. Dick:

Under the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Rules, Permits to Operate are issued in 5-year increments. Solid Waste Section records indicate that the Permit to Operate for the above referenced facility is past due for the next 5-year phase of operation.

The NC Solid Waste Section has reviewed the November 19, 2009 LCID Permit Application for the above referenced facility and is requesting additional information prior to issuing the permit renewal for the D & D Grading, Inc. LCID Landfill. The LCID permit application, and in particular the Operations Plan, must contain all of the information detailed in the enclosed guidance document. Clarification is also required regarding the total acreage and total gross capacity in cubic yards of the entire LCID facility as well as the acreage and capacity of each of the planned 5-year phases. The November 2009 application and associated site drawing references Phase 1A only. Please be sure to include acreage and capacity of the previous phase of operation at the LCID and revise the site drawing to indicate current LCID activity in addition to the planned operation of Phase 1A.
