The Solid Waste Section has scheduled a Public Notice regarding the issuance of a draft Permit to Operate (PTO) to Halifax County Construction and Demolition Debris Landfill (C&DLF) - Area 1 which is located on top of the closed unlined Municipal Solid Waste Landfill (MSWLF). The landfill facility is located in Halifax County, North Carolina. The draft PTO approves Halifax County's requests to (1) further expand vertically the final fill elevation from 346 feet above mean sea level (amsl) to 358 feet amsl within the same 6.5-acre footprints, resulting in increasing the total gross capacity to 131,267 cubic yards (cy) from the originally capacity of 75,000 cy and (2) to continue operations C&DLF - Area 1 pursuant to the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Rules 15A NCAC 13B .0547(4).

The 45-day comment period is scheduled to begin on **January 30, 2011** and end on **March 15, 2011**. Public hearings have been conducted in accordance with the Solid Waste Management Rules to address the continued operation of the C&DLF and the Corrective Action Plan for the closed MSWLF by the Halifax County. The Solid Waste Section believes the pertinent issues involved in the permit decision may properly be addressed in these hearings and does not schedule to conduct a public hearing at this time. However, any person interested in a public hearing on this draft permit should notify the division contact in writing which must be received by 5:00 pm, **March 15, 2011**. The Division may hold a public hearing if there is a significant degree of public interest.

Attached are the Public Notice for issuance of draft PTO which is prepared in accordance with 15A NCAC 13B .0533(c)(4) and the Fact Sheet. I am requesting that the public notice be posted in the local newspapers and any other news outlets you might deem appropriate. The posting must be accomplished on or before **January 30, 2011** to comply with the Administrative Code. Thank you in advance for your assistance in this matter.
