Hello Larry, Pieter, Lenore, Rich, and Don,

As we discussed in our recent meeting, an application for permit amendment (renewal) for the Halifax County Coal Ash Monofill should be submitted as soon as possible to bring the site into compliance, because the permit has long expired.

For permit renewal, the following should be submitted:

1. General information as listed in the guidance to my letter dated Aug.9, 2011 (see attached). Items listed in #6 and #7 would be helpful to our permit review if it is readily available, but is not required for the renewal.
2. Updated Operations Plan, as listed in the letter. Details regarding capacity and fill contours can be provided with the PTC application instead of the renewal application.
3. Financial assurance, as listed in the guidance. Closure and post-closure costs should be based on closure conditions as last permitted.
4. Signature page.
5. Engineering site drawing, if any site features have changed from the previous site plan drawing,

After we receive the application for permit renewal, a permit fee invoice will be sent to the County for \$18,500. This permit fee will cover both the permit renewal and the Permit to Construct for the next phase. However, the Permit to Operate the next phase will be a permit modification fee of \$2,500.

We understand that an application for Permit to Construct the next phase will be submitted in the first quarter of 2012.

The application for permit amendment (renewal) should be submitted to our office by November 15, 2011.
