SOLID WASTE PERMIT

Conditions of Permit:

1. This permit may be subject to review at an administrative hearing upon petition of anyone whose legal rights, privileges and duties may have been affected by the issuance thereof.
2. The following requirements shall be met prior to receiving solid waste at the site:
 - a. Filing of the certified copy of the permit with the register of deeds.
 - b. Site preparation in accordance with operational plan.
 - c. Site inspection made by a representative of the Division of Health Services.
 - d. Posting of the solid waste permit number on the entrance sign to the landfill.
3. Groundwater monitoring wells must be installed as indicated on sheet 5 of the operational plan.
4. A copy of the operational plan must be kept available for use by the site operator.
5. Modifications to all erosion and sediment control devices, including installation and location of stone check dams, stone filter berm construction, silt fence installation, and revised velocities of all water outlets, as outlined in John Holley's (Regional Engineer, Land Quality Section, DNRCD) letter (to follow under separate cover) should be addressed.
