

CONDITIONS OF PERMIT

1. This permit is issued for a period not to exceed three (3) years from the date of issuance and/or amendment, subject to condition number 2. This permit is for the construction and operation of the tire collection site set forth in the attached application. Additional conditions or revisions to the approved plans or operations must be approved by the Solid Waste Section.

Amendments or revisions to the Solid Waste Management Rules or violation of surface water, groundwater, or land quality standards may necessitate modification of construction, operation, or closure of this facility prior to the expiration date of this permit.

2. This tire collection site is permitted to store, prior to processing, not more than twenty-three thousand and seventy six (23,076) tires. Proof of closure, clean up, and liability financial assurance, including pollution coverage, must also be submitted at that time for the potential amount of storage equal to the monthly processing amount.

Subsequent adjustments to the storage amount and financial assurance amounts require approval of the Solid Waste Section.

3. A minimum of seventy-five percent (75%) of tire derived products must be disposed in Central Carolina Tire Disposal's tire monofill or shipped off-site on an annual basis. Adjustments to this percentage to allow additional amounts of storage or adjustments to allow additional length of storage time must be approved by the Solid Waste Section.

4. Closure and clean up financial assurance must remain in force during the operation of this site and is subject to Condition Number 2. Central Carolina Tire Disposal must submit to the Division for approval, any subsequent changes in the instrument or provider of financial assurance at least one-hundred-twenty (120) days prior to said change. **This permit is immediately revoked if any lapse of closure and clean up financial assurance occurs.**
5. Liability financial assurance must remain in force during the operation of this site and is subject to Condition Number 2. Central Carolina Tire Disposal must submit to the Division for approval, any subsequent changes in the instrument or provider of liability financial assurance, at least one-hundred-twenty (120) days prior to said change. **This permit is immediately revoked if any lapse of liability financial assurance occurs.**
6. This facility shall conform to the operating procedures set forth under section 0.1107 of the Solid Waste Management Rules and the following specific conditions:
 - a. Within one (1) month after termination of operations at the site or a major portion thereof or upon revocation of this permit, all scrap tire and scrap tire derived products shall be removed to a permitted solid waste management facility approved to received this type of waste.
 - b. The Division may require further action to be taken in order to correct any condition which is or may become injurious to the public health or environment.
 - c. Adequate fire protection measures shall be in place and fire prevention procedures shall be practiced at all times. Equipment shall be provided to control accidental fires or arrangements shall be made with the local fire protection agency to immediately provide fire-fighting services when needed.
 - d. Adequate control measures and practices shall be employed to prevent any pollutants from contaminating surface water, groundwater, and soil.
 - e. A copy of the Emergency Preparedness Manual must be kept readily available to employees on the site at all times.

- f. The site shall be adequately secured to prevent unauthorized entry. An attendant shall be on duty at the site at all times while it is open for public use to assure compliance with operation requirements.
 - g. Tires shall be stored in accordance with the amended site plan dated 30 October 1994, received 3 November 1994, to include the work/storage area, those tire storage areas North, South and East of the work/storage area, and in accordance with the original permit application. Any proposed changes in storage or procedures shall require approval by the Solid Waste Section. Outdoor tire storage shall comply with 15 NCAC 13B .1107 (2).
 - h. The Irrevocable Standby Letter Of Credit No. 3880, issued on February 15, 1995 shall be renewed by Central Carolina Tire Disposal and submitted to the Division of Solid Waste by February 14, 1996 and each year thereafter.
- 7. A report shall be submitted annually on March 1 to the Division and to Harnett County containing the information required under 15A NCAC 13B. 1110 (d).
 - 8. A sign with the name of the facility and permit number must be erected and maintained at the entrance of the facility.
 - 9. In accordance with 15 NCAC 13B 0.1102 (b), Scrap Tire Collection or Disposal Sites shall pay an annual permit renewal fee, by July 1, of each year, as specified:
 - (1) A scrap tire collection site: two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00); and
 - (2) A scrap tire disposal site: two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00).

Both the sight draft and certification must bear on their face the clause, "Drawn under United Carolina Bank, Clinton, North Carolina, Irrevocable Standby Letter of Credit No. 3880 dated February 15, 1995."

We engage with you that drafts drawn under and in compliance with the terms of this credit will be met with due honor upon their presentation to the principal office of United Carolina Bank, 300 Fayetteville Street, Clinton, North Carolina 28328 on or before February 15, 1996. We further engage with you that, at your sole option, this Irrevocable Standby Letter of Credit shall inure to the benefit of any co-sureties or reinsurers who may share any applicable risk with you, although only the Division of Solid Waste Management may draw upon this letter of credit. Further, this letter of credit is non-transferable.

This Irrevocable Standby Letter of Credit does not contain any automatic extensions and expires at 5:00 PM, Raleigh, North Carolina time on February 15, 1996. 



Proof of closure, clean up, and liability financial assurance, including pollution coverage, must also be submitted at that time for the potential amount of storage equal to the monthly processing amount.

Receiving Procedures

DATE 1/4/95 BY DJD

Tires are received from county governments, private individuals and private businesses. Tires received from county governments are transported by Central Carolina Tire Disposal (CCTD) or haulers contracted to CCTD.

Arriving trucks are weighed at the gate using "Unibridge" scales. For the purposes of reporting, tire count is estimated at the rate of 100 tires per ton.

Unloading and Storage for Processing

Tires are unloaded by CCTD personnel in the order of arrival. Trucks and trailers arriving from the scales are located for unloading in the designated "Work / Storage Area". They are positioned within the Work / Storage Area based on quantity, type, and size of tire. Tires are unloaded, sorted, and graded. Tires suitable for recycling are processed and stored for pick up in the Work / Storage Area.

Tires not suitable for recycling are moved to a Storage Area for further processing. Rimmed tires are moved to a Storage Area for removal of the rims and further processing of the tires for recycling or monofilling. The rims are crushed and stored for pick up by scrap metal recyclers. Non-recyclable tires are processed for deposition in the tire monofill by shredding or splitting. Tires received before 1 pm are processed the same day. Tires received during the remainder of day are processed the next day.

CCTD has the current capability to process tires at a rate of 1,000 to 1,500 tires per hour using a single shredder, Shredding Systems, model 2400. Current operating hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. monday through saturday with an 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. shift on sunday as needed.

Large truck tires, large equipment tires, and large agricultural tires are removed from the work area upon receipt and moved to a specific Storage Area. This allows maximum recycling opportunity and credit for these tires. Tires in these areas remain in storage for a maximum of two days prior to being split.

Once tires are processed they are removed from the processing site for monofilling or recycling.

Fire Prevention

Tire Storage Areas are delineated by yellow posts to contain tires within 50' x 200' areas with 50' fire lanes separating these areas.

Within the Work / Storage Area tires may be stored. However, tires stored overnight must be located a minimum of 50 feet from the shop and shredder structures. No storage pile may be greater than 50' x 200'. Minimum 50' wide fire lanes must exist between storage piles. Fire lanes must be kept clear of obstruction.

The Operations Supervisor is present on site continuously during operations. His duties include inspection for fire hazards, correction of hazards, and inspection for fires.

A night watchman is on duty each night from 5 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday evening through Saturday morning and from 5 a.m. Sunday to 5 a.m. Monday. He inspects the site for fires once per hour and prevents strangers from accessing the site.

The Harnett County Fire Marshall's Office or the local fire department will be invited by CCTD to visit the site once per year to inspect the site and become familiar with operations and locations of tire storage / processing areas. Records of these visits are to be obtained from the inspecting / visiting fire official and maintained in the on-site operating records.

The Spout Springs Fire Department is 4 miles distant.

Telephones for fire notification are located in the shop adjacent to the Work Area and in the scale house at the gate.

In the event of fire the fire department is notified via telephone (911). Heavy equipment at the site will be used to construct earthen berms down gradient in ravines draining from the fire. These berms are to contain molten rubber from the fire and to contain water & other debris washed from the fire during fire fighting. The Operations Supervisor is responsible for directing construction of berms. Upon arrival of firefighters, the Operations Supervisor serves as a guide for the firefighters to orient them in the event the site is obscured by smoke and to answer their questions relative to location of flammables, water, phones, etc.

Vector Control

Whole tires and sliced scrap tires, and other scrap tires capable of holding water shall be covered upon receipt with a water shedding material or disposed of, processed or removed from the site within 10 days of receipt. Sliced (split) scrap tires stacked concave-side down are not required to be covered.

Currently the site accepts approximately 8,800 tires per day. Approximately 1,500 tires per day are exported for recycling. The remaining approximately 7,300 tires per day are processed for monofilling. Tire recyclers pick up whole tires from the site on a daily basis. Since the site has the capability to shred between 1,000 and 1,500 tires per hour, it is unlikely that whole tires would remain on site for 10 or more days, except during periods of extended shredder maintenance.

(5) The Company is a multipurpose operation,
offering pick-up from several County
sanitary landfills. This entails provided
trailers at the landfill, or loading and
hauling piles of loose tires. Scrap tires
included passenger car, truck, and heavy and
off-road tires.

The Company also contracts with individual
tire dealers to pick up and dispose of tires
at the dealerships, or accepts delivery from same.

Approximately 20% of tires received at the
facility are set aside for either resale as
used tires, resale as recappable tires or
other recyclable uses. At present, 5% of these
tires are passenger car tires and 15% are
truck tires.

Signed areas will be designated for three categories of reusable (recyclable) tires. These areas are shown on the enclosed site plan. No more than 1,000 of each type tire will be stored at any given time. These tires will be stored separately by category, provided with fire lanes at all times, and either removed from the site, shredded, covered, or landfilled within a two week period.

Existing shredder is manufactured by Shredding Systems with a 300 HP electric motor, and a rate of 1500 tires per hr. The shredder will discharge onto a conveyor system which will dump into a 40 Cubic Yard "dumpster" type container. Each container will hold approximately 1600 tires. Two containers will be available at the site; a truck will, when a container is full, immediately haul the shredded tires to the tire monofill to be disposed of in accordance with the requirements of the Monofill Permit.

- (6) As previously indicated, scrap tires will be picked up and/or delivered to the site from counties, dealers and other facilities requiring disposal of scrap tires. Maximum expected volume at present is 75,000 tires/month. Up to 20% of these tires will be removed from the site to be sold as used tires, be recapped or recycled for other uses.
- (7) All scrap tires which are not resold or recycled will be disposed of at the Central Carolina Tire Monofill Permit No. 43-04. This facility is on the same site as the proposed Tire Processing Facility. Address is same.
- (8) Operation has commenced.
- (9) Waste will be disposed of in the tire monofill.
- (10) Previously described. In addition, the company has retained a Registered Professional Engineer to routinely oversee the construction and operation of this facility.


