The review of the above-referenced erosion control plan has been completed. The plan has been found to be acceptable subject to the following stipulations:

1. This permit is not valid prior to release of mining permit #43-18 which is dependant on the entire site (24.61 acres) being permitted by the Division of Solid Waste for an LCID landfill.
2. Additional erosion and sediment control measures will be required if the existing pit is dewatered by pumping.
3. This permit is not valid for transporting borrow material offsite.
4. Enclosed is a Certificate of Plan Approval which must be displayed at the job site.
5. In order to ensure the early coordination and implementation of the erosion control plan for this project, it is requested that a preconstruction conference be held. As a minimum, representatives of the owner, engineer, contractor, and this office should attend, subject to the availability of staff. 

As requested, a representative of **Froehling and Robertson, Inc. (F&R)** was present at this site on April 5, 2000 to observe the installation of two hand auger borings at this site. The hand auger borings were excavated to determine the depth to the groundwater. Each of the hand auger borings were advanced to a depth of 4.5 to 5 feet below the ground surface. The elevations of the test borings indicate that there is at least The locations of the hand auger borings are shown on the attached sketch. The borings were advanced in the lower portions of a sand pit borrow area. The elevations of the borings are also indicated on the attached sketch.

Test boring BH-1 encountered an 18-inch thick layer of slightly silty medium sand (SP-SM) at the ground surface. These sands were underlain by fine to medium sandy clay (CL) and clayey fine to medium sand (SC) to the termination depth of 5.0 feet below the ground surface. All of the encountered soils in test boring BH-1 were moist. Test boring BH-2 encountered very wet, clayey sand at the ground surface. The clayey sand was encountered to a depth of approximately 2 feet below the ground surface. Below this depth, very wet fine to medium sandy clay (CL) was encountered to the boring termination depth of 4.5 feet.

At a period of 48 hours after the hand auger borings were excavated, this representative returned to the site and measured the depth to water. In test boring BH-1, water was encountered at a depth of 4.5 feet below the ground surface. In test boring BH-2, water was encountered at a depth of 14 inches below the ground surface.

Based upon the site topography of the borrow area, and the vegetation which has grown up since the mining operations were terminated, it appears that there are several areas, in the lowest portions of the pit, which hold water during periods of heavy rain. At the time of our site reconnaissance, there were areas of previously ponded water in the vicinity of test boring BH-1, while the areas adjacent to test borings BH-2 had standing water present. It appears that surface water run-off ponds in the lowest areas of the pit.

Based upon these observations, the observed depth to groundwater appears to be deeper than 4 feet below the existing ground surface in the area of test boring BH-1. Based upon the wet soil conditions in the area of BH-2, it is likely that the shallow water depth is due to a perched groundwater condition. We note that the elevation of test boring BH-1 is 5.25 feet lower in elevation than BH-2.
