**REPORT:**

Spevco Incorporated is a manufacturer of multipurpose trailers, including NASCAR trailers, medical vehicles, and mobile broadcast trailers. The facility consists of three buildings – Building A Main Manufacturing, Building B Paint Booth and Body Work, and Building C Maintenance and Refurbishment.

The facility has about 110 employees and is on 10 acres. The nearest residence is adjacent to the property line. The facility uses city water and has a septic tank. It is estimated to be over 1 mile to the nearest well.

The facility generates about 55-gallons of hazardous waste each 4 months. The facility was inspected as a CEG.

The manufacturing process begins with fabrication of the chassis and frame. Plumbing and electrical work is done, and then the unit is painted.

There is one paint booth. There was a 5-gallon satellite accumulation containers at the spray booth and a 55-gallon container of paint waste in the storage area. Ecoflo hauls the waste from the facility.

A recirculating parts cleaner that uses mineral spirits is used in Building C. Used oil is accumulated in an approximately 300-gallon tank, which was labeled “Used Oil.” No universal waste was observed.

## **CONCLUSIONS**

Spevco Incorporated is operating as a CEG. No violations were observed.
