As conveyed in my telephone messages in the morning of June 9, the SWS approves elimination of MW-9 from the Environmental Monitoring Plan. A revised Environmental Monitoring Plan (plan) should be submitted to reflect the change. Although questions about MW-9 remain unanswered, the SWS concluded that, at this time and based on currently provided data, MW-3 and MW-3D are sufficient for monitoring the existing leachate lagoon, and MW-4A and MW-8 are sufficient for monitoring existing Phase 1. More direction regarding updating the plan will be communicated later. However, below is one direction.

Please include in the revised Environmental Monitoring Plan a map showing hydrogeologic data south of Phases 1,2,3, and 4. You indicated in your previous email (Doc ID 11052) that a groundwater map of this area exists in the semi-annual groundwater monitoring report submitted to the Field Operations Branch. This map had not been included in the Design Hydrogeologic Report (Doc ID 7040) or previous Environmental Monitoring Plan (Doc ID 5808) submitted to the Permitting Branch. Consolidating information in a revised Environmental Monitoring Plan submitted to the Permitting Branch should help answer questions about MW-20, MW-11, MW-11D, and other components of the water quality monitoring plan for the site.

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
