Dear Mr. Thompson:

The schedule submitted by Cargan Resources, Inc. on behalf of Henderson County is acceptable with the provision that measures be taken to monitor methane migration at the northern boundary of the landfill adjacent to property owned by Dr. Trace, and at all landfill facility structures. Should monitoring results indicate landfill gas migration exceeding standards in close proximity to structures on the Trace property, or in landfill structures, the county must:

1. Immediately take all steps to ensure protection of human health, notify the Division and affected property owner(s).
2. Within seven days of detection, place in the operating record the methane gas levels detected and a description of steps taken to protect human health.


Dear Mr. Foscue:

On behalf of Henderson County I would like to set forth our development plans for the captioned project. Subject to the availability of a suitable drilling rig, the receipt of the appropriate State of North Carolina permits, and the weather related site conditions, our development schedule should proceed as follows:

1. March 1994....Produce plans and specifications for project, submit permits for project approval, and initiate field work including locating and staking well sites and manifold routing.
2. April 1994....Begin site construction, including plant site work, installation of landfill gas wells gathering lines and manifolds.
3. May through August 1994....Complete project construction and installation of landfill gas production equipment.
4. September 1994....Plant start-up, systems testing and evaluation, safety inspection, commence operations.
