Larry,

The attached drawing shows the area we discussed this morning that Henderson County would like to consider using as a Beneficial Fill Area / Beneficial Fill Processing Area. This area is in the northeast corner of the Facility and is presently used as the Mulching & Grinding / Temporary Disaster Debris Staging Area. This area would continue to be used as the mulching & grinding operation / temporary disaster debris staging area with the beneficial fill / beneficial fill processing operation being added to the allowable uses. Basically the beneficial fill material would be brought to the site and stockpiled for future processing. Once enough was accumulated an outside contractor could be brought in to process the material into a more readily useable product. However, any fill material not processed would be graded to provide positive drainage of the area surface with final overall contours in general conformance with the contours shown on the attachment. Outside slopes would be maintained at approximately a 4:1 slope and would be covered with soil material and grassed as the elevation of the site increased. The County may use the initial beneficial fill material to generally cover/floor-in this area to provide a more readily accessible site for the processing of the wood debris and future stockpiling of the beneficial fill.

The reason for this request is that the old beneficial fill area that was just west of the closed C&D Landfill is no longer accessible and the County would like to continue the present practice of separating the beneficial fill material from the waste stream that is being sent off the site for disposal. The old beneficial fill area is now being graded for the construction of the new Citizen's Convenience Center.


