
Enclosed you will find a copy of Permit No. 4504, dated April 12, 2011, DIN 13594. The Permit amendment is issued for the five (5) year permit renewal and the continued operation of the Henderson County Municipal Solid Waste Transfer Facility, located at the Stoney Mountain Road Landfill. Make note of the following items;

- Copies of this permit, the approved plans, and all records, are required to be maintained by the permittee at the facility and made available to the Section upon request during normal business hours.
- On April 13, 2011 I received an email entitled;  
*Proposed area for Beneficial Fill and/or Processing – Stoney Mountain Road Landfill*. Prepared for Henderson County. Prepared by McGill Associates. April 13, 2011. DIN 13618.

The email requests permission to begin a beneficial fill and/or processing activity in the same area designated as "Mulching and Grinding/Temporary Disaster Debris Staging Area" in the approved plans. The County may engage in the beneficial fill activity in the proposed area, as long as the proposed activity is accomplished in accordance with North Carolina Administrative Code 15A NCAC 13B .0562. Should the County be unable to accomplish the proposed activity in accordance with the Administrative Code, the County will be required to apply for either a Modification or Amendment to the existing Permit to Operate.
