Hertford County Transfer Station Operation Plan Revision:

The transfer station is covered with open sides and on occasion a small amount of rain can be blown onto the floor. Also water can and is part of the waste that is tipped onto the concrete pad.

The free standing liquids that appear on the concrete pad will either be removed with the waste as it is being loaded into the compactors or by vacuuming with a 50 gallon shop vacuum. The vacuumed water will then be disposed in a waste water treatment facility along with the condensate generated by the methane gas collection system.
