On May 27, 2008 the Division of Waste Management received your Request entitled;

- *Type I Small Composting Unit Request for Acknowledgement Letter (RAL)*. Dated May 19, 2008. Document ID No. 4596.

The Division has reviewed your RAL for a Small Type I Composting Unit, located within the facility boundaries of the Jackson County Municipal Solid Waste Transfer Facility, and found it to be complete. The Division hereby issues this Acknowledgement Letter as formal approval to operate the Unit. The Letter has been incorporated by reference into the approved facility operating permit and is subject to review on the five year cycle of the parent facility. The County is responsible for the proper operation of the Compost Unit, in accordance with the applicable portions of North Carolina Administrative Code 15A NCAC 13B.1400. If it hasn't already been done, the County should immediately update its Operations Plan to include the Composting Unit.

It should also be noted, the permit number you listed on the form (50-001) is incorrect. The state assigned permit number for the Jackson County Transfer Station is 50-03T. I have made the correction on the RAL form so no further action is required on your part.
