As long as the new site location is located outside of the Johnston County solid waste permitted area, meets out setbacks (which it does), and you can continue to properly control access to the new site, the location is fine with me. The current permit does not require any permit language modifications to note the new site location. I will put the new location map in the file with a note, and you can begin construction. Remember to contact the Regional Office prior to operation and after construction is complete.

The east branch ends after another 60 feet at the Bulk Fill Station. The west branch goes to a sludge press facility.
