You are hereby advised that, pursuant to N.C.G.S. 130A-22, an administrative penalty of up to \$15,000 per day may be assessed for each violation of the Solid Waste Statute or Regulations. AREAS OF CONCERN AND COMMENTS:

1. The facility is permitted as a Large Type 3 Solid Waste Compost Facility.
2. The Permit Application and Operations Manual are currently in the process of technical review and comments from the Section. The Permit Application and Operations Manual were prepared by City of Sanford Engineer Victor I. Czar, P.E.
3. Signage posted at facility indicates permit number, emergency contact numbers and hours of operation. The hours of operation are 8am-5pm Monday to Friday. Signage at the entrance appears to be correct.



4. The facility primarily receives materials in November and December leaf pickups from the City of Sanford residents.



Leaves are blended with chicken manure to obtain the correct C: N ratio and placed into windrows. The facility utilizes a pull-behind 616 Wildcat windrow turner.



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5. Analytical results for fecal coli form and Waste analysis with metals, C: N ratio, total solids were reviewed. Foreign matter needs to be obtained and recorded. Logging sheet with temperatures must be clearly recorded to demonstrate product is meeting PFRP and VAR. **A recommended composting log sheet was sent to the facility by NC DWM's reviewing engineer on December 02, 2009.**
6. Ensure that all items listed in the operational procedures section of the technical review dated December 16, 2009, are implemented in your daily operations.
7. It was recommended during the inspection that a storm-water compost sock or other device be used around the perimeter of the active composting areas to prevent run-off.
8. There are two (2) fire-hydrants located at the top of the main windrow area, one near the entrance gate and one near the second windrow area on the county maintenance site.
9. The area where street sweepings comingled with leaves needs to be cleaned up, removed and properly disposed of at a lined MSWLF. Please provide weigh tickets for the materials removed and notify this office of completion within thirty (30) days.
