Enclosed please find the above-referenced Permit to Operate (PTO) which approves Lenoir County's request for extending disposal operations in the existing Phase 1 area, encompassing waste footprints approximately 10.53 acres. The approved disposal capacity for Phase 1 is approximately 658,424 cubic yards consistent with the final contour as shown on Drawing PR/Sheet No. 1 of 1 dated October 05, 2009 and prepared by Municipal Engineering Services Co., Inc. (MESCO). The PTO for Phase 1 will be expired on February 18, 2015, and the Phase 1 shall be operated under the terms and conditions of the approved permit documents and applicable statutes and rules in effect on this PTO issuance date.

Issuance of this PTO does not grant any authorization for disposal operations in any other future phases within the approved landfill property. Any additional permit issued before this permit expiration dated will require payment of the statutorily required permit modification fee as specified in the Division of Waste Management (DWM) letter dated November 19, 2009. The amount of the modification fee will be based on the annual tonnage disposed at the time of the application.

Please be aware of the GENERAL PERMIT CONDITION NO. 3; one copy of the permit must be recorded in the Register of Deeds office in Lenoir County and sent back to the Solid Waste Section to my attention. Please also remember that financial assurance must be kept current and updated annually to reflect changes in the rules, operation of the sites, and inflation.
