Mr. Huff:

This letter is intended to clarify the requirements for making a change in the facility boundary at the closed Madison County MSW Landfill Facility. A revised *Landfill Gas Monitoring Plan* (DIN 10430) submitted on your behalf by McGill Associates was received by the Section on April 23, 2010. Figure 1 within this document indicates a new facility boundary which has been displaced from the property line to exclude existing structures. While the *Landfill Gas Monitoring Plan* has been approved by the Section, the change in facility boundary can only be approved through a permitting modification or amendment activity. A change in the facility boundary constitutes a change in the previously approved Facility Plan which, in accordance with NCGS 130A-295.8, requires approval of the Section and submission of a permit modification or amendment fee. In order to establish a new facility boundary you must submit a specific request indicating the previously approved boundary and the new proposed boundary including a discussion of the reason for the change.
