Dear Mr. Whitehurst:

Please find enclosed the Permit to Construct and Operate for the C&D Landfill, Permit No. 74-07, which approves the construction of Phase 2A of the landfill, the increase in service area, the increase in the allowable daily disposal rate, and the continued operation of Phase 1.

In general, the new facility permit does not reiterate permit conditions which are included in the Solid Waste Management Rules, 15A NCAC 13B, nor does it restate specific conditions which are included within the approved plans, such as site specific operations.

Among the many permit conditions for the landfill, we bring to your particular attention condition 3 on page 4, which requires that the permit be recorded at the Register of Deeds and returned to this office within 30 days; and also condition 31 on page 14, which requires submittal of the revised financial assurance mechanism to the Section before the issuance of the Phase 2A PTO, and no later than September 21, 2009.

The Solid Waste Section approves the closure plan, post-closure plan, and financial responsibility documents submitted with the Phase 2 PTC application, which also satisfy the requirements of 15A NCAC 13B .0547 (2) for Phase 1 of the landfill. The requirements of this rule will be satisfied when the financial assurance instrument has been submitted. The approved costs, in year 2009 dollar values, are \$1,404,675 for closure activities, and \$1,243,500 for the 30 year post-closure activities.
