Dear Mr. Whitehurst:

Please find enclosed the Permit to Operate for the C&D Landfill, Permit No. 74-07, which approves the operation of Phase 2A of the landfill, the increase in service area, the increase in the allowable daily disposal rate, and the continued operation of Phase 1. The Permit to Operate expires July 21, 2014.

In general, the new facility permit does not reiterate permit conditions which are included in the Solid Waste Management Rules, 15A NCAC 13B, nor does it restate specific conditions which are included within the approved plans, such as site specific operations.

Among the many permit conditions for the landfill, we bring to your particular attention condition 4 on page 7, which requires permanent edge of waste markers. The edge of waste markers also applies to the northern boundary of the certified Phase 2A area.
