Dear Mr. King:

Enclosed is Permit No. 92-27T for the Thornton Road Mixed Waste Transfer Station in Wake County. The Permit reflects the requested permit property ownership change from Mr. Lemuel H. Thornton to Dynasty Holdings, LLC; permit operator change from PCM Construction Services, LLC to Shotwell Transfer Station, Inc.; property changes; and facility name change to Thornton Road Mixed Waste Transfer Station. The Permit also includes conditions for the construction of the new facility and operation of the existing facility during construction. The construction of new facilities will allow the transfer station to accept municipal solid waste in addition to construction and debris waste.

In general, the new facility permit does not reiterate permit conditions which are included in the Solid Waste Management Rules, 15A NCAC 13B, nor does it restate specific conditions which are included within the approved plans.
