The Solid Waste Section has prepared Draft Solid Waste Permit No. 92-28, which would allow the existing Red Rock Disposal Construction and Demolition Debris (C&D) landfill to increase the service area of the facility. The C&D landfill is currently approved to accept waste generated within Wake County and contiguous counties. The proposed new facility permit would allow the facility to accept waste generated within 59 North Carolina counties which are predominantly within a one hundred mile radius of the landfill. No changes are proposed at this time to increase the size of the landfill or to increase the volume (tons per day) that the facility is allowed to receive.

The Red Rock Disposal C&D Landfill is owned and operated by Waste Industries, Inc., and is located south of Rex Road, at 7130 New Landfill Road, southwest of Holly Springs in Wake County.

A 45-day comment period begins April 7, 2008, and ends at 5:00 PM on May 21, 2008. Comments concerning the terms and conditions of the proposed permit should be submitted in writing to Donna Wilson, Division Contact, at the address listed above, before the close of the comment period. The permit number must be included on all correspondence.

Interested parties may obtain copies of the fact sheet and draft permit from the division contact. All data submitted by the applicant as part of the administrative record may be viewed, by appointment, between 9 AM and 4 PM Monday- Friday at the Division of Waste Management, 401 Oberlin Road, Suite 150, Raleigh, NC. A portion of the administrative record, including the application, fact sheet, and draft permit, may be viewed online at <http://www.wastenotnc.org/sw/swdocuments.asp> (select 9228 in the permit box, then click Search Documents).

A public hearing has not been scheduled for this permit. However, during the public comment period any interested person may request a public hearing. A request for public hearing shall be in writing and shall state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing.

After the close of the public comment period, the Solid Waste Section will issue a permit decision. Each person who has submitted a written request for notice of the permit decision shall receive written notification of the decision.
