Dear Mr. Johnson:

Enclosed is Permit No. 92-28 for the Red Rock Disposal C&D Landfill in Wake County. The Permit was modified to increase the service area of the facility from 8 counties to 59 North Carolina counties, and also approves the construction debris sorting and recycling operation demonstration project.

The Solid Waste Section has determined the pre-operative conditions have been met for Solid Waste Permit No. 92-28, Part 1: Permit to Construct for Phase 1, Cell 1C-2 and associated facility infrastructure. This permit also approves the operation of Cell 1C-2.

The Solid Waste Section has received and reviewed the closure plan, post-closure plan, and financial responsibility documents submitted in accordance with 15A NCAC 13B .0547 (2) for Phase 1 of the landfill. The requirements of this rule will be satisfied for this landfill when the financial assurance instrument for closure and post-closure costs have been submitted. Permit condition Attachment 4, Part I, condition 10 requires submittal of the instrument by August 1, 2008.

An extension to the schedule for placement of final cover for Phase 1 has been granted for the term of this permit to operate. This extension is described in permit condition Attachment 4, Part I, condition 13.d.

In general, the new facility permit does not reiterate permit conditions which are included in the Solid Waste Management Rules, 15A NCAC 13B, nor does it restate specific conditions which are included within the approved plans.
