Please find enclosed the Permit to Operate for the Capitol Waste C&D Transfer Station, Permit No. 92-37T-Transfer-2010, which approves ownership of the facility by David W. King, Jr. The Permit to Operate expires May 4, 2012.

In general, the new facility permit does not reiterate permit conditions which are included in the Solid Waste Management Rules, 15A NCAC 13B, nor does it restate specific conditions which are included within the approved plans, such as site specific operations.

Among the many permit conditions for the landfill, we bring to your particular attention condition 3 on page 3, which requires that the entire permit be recorded at the Register of Deeds. A certified copy of the permit has been enclosed for the recordation. Also, condition 25 on page 10 requires the submittal of proof of financial assurance by July 15, 2010.
