Dear Ms. Doty:

The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) received a letter (DIN 6136) notifying the Section of a change in location for the proposed ASU Greenhouse at the closed Watauga County MSW landfill. This letter was received by the Section on October 31, 2008. Attached to this letter was a photocopy of an aerial image of the facility near the existing County Animal Shelter. The facility boundary for the closed MSW unit was indicated in pink highlighter and labeled. The new location for the proposed ASU Greenhouse, across the access road, was indicated on the photocopy and also labeled.

Providing the following conditions are met, there should be no need for a permit modification regarding the construction of the greenhouse:

1. The facility boundary for the closed MSW unit is accurate.
2. The location of the proposed greenhouse does not interfere with any monitoring wells.
3. The indicated location is representative of where the greenhouse will be constructed.

If these conditions are not met, or this information is found to be incorrect, you will need to notify the Section and request a permit action.
