After reviewing Permit Condition #31 in the Permit to Construct and Operate issued for the Wayne County MSW Landfill on June 13, 2011 the Solid Waste Section has determined that hydrogen sulfide is not explicitly required to be monitored at municipal solid waste landfills (MSWLFs) in accordance with the Solid Waste Management Rule 15A NCAC 13B .1626 (4). Therefore, this part of the permit requirement is not applicable to your facility. Hydrogen sulfide is a dangerous gas and toxic at very low levels. Please be aware during the routine operations of your landfill. If you have any further questions, you may contact me at (919)508-8506.
