Dear Mr. Jones:

North Carolina General Statute 130A-309.09D (b) requires that, on or before August 1st of each year, all solid waste management facilities shall report to the Department, for the previous year beginning July 1st and ending June 30th, the amount by weight of the solid waste that was received at the facility and disposed of in a landfill, or recovered for recycling. As of this date, we have not received your Treatment and Processing Facility Annual Report.

Based upon the foregoing, you are in Violation of North Carolina General Statute 130A-309.09D (b). Please comply by submitting the completed Facility Annual report within 5 days of receipt of this Notice of Violation. If the facility has not accepted waste, note that on the Report.

Pursuant to G.S. 130A-22(a) and 15A NC Administrative Code 13B Section .0701 - .0707, an administrative penalty of up to \$15,000.00 per day may be assessed for violations of the Solid Waste Law or Regulations.
