Louisiana-Pacific Industrial Landfill  
Wilkes County, Permit #97-03, Document ID No. 13499

Mr. Hart:

The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) has received a letter (DIN13439) requesting a 12 month extension of the Permit to Construct for the landfill expansion project. The letter was received in the Asheville Regional Office on March 29, 2011.

The Section has determined, since there is no allowance in the statutes or rules, an extension cannot be granted. However, when Louisiana-Pacific is ready to begin construction on the expansion you would only need to request a modification to the Permit to Construct. This would require payment of a permit modification activity fee, but, assuming no changes in the statutes or rules, the Section would issue a new Permit with a revised issuance date allowing for another 18 month period to begin substantial construction. No compliance action will result from missing the deadline and there is no need for further communication with the Section, regarding this activity, until you are ready to begin construction.
