Project: Tarp Demonstration Inspection

On January 23, 2009, John Patrone met with Kent Brandon and Phil Greene and conducted an inspection of the Tarp Demonstration being conducted at the Wilkes County MSWLF.

Mr. Patrone observed the removal of the two tarps. The tarps were observed in place (prior to removal) and when being removed. The tarps appeared to have adequately covered the intended area. Both tarps were used in conjunction with one another.

The facility appeared to have maintained the tarps in good order. No rips or holes were noticed. Tarp demonstration records were reviewed from January 13th through January 22, 2009. According to the facility's tarp evaluation records, the tarp is used as required: 5 days of continual usage then 2 days of soil cover. When the tarp is not used the facility records the reason why (ex. rain, holiday, etc.).

The working face appeared to be in good order. No windblown material was observed. Staff removes the tarps from the working face ~ 6:30 am.

The facility purchased a hand-held Spectra Integrated Systems - Trimble Site Controller Software (utilizing GPS) in order to measure landfill material compaction and grade. Mr. Greene stated that a new compactor may be purchased, in about 1 year, which will contain Spectra I.S. – Trimble technology.
