Dear Mr. Pflieger:

The Solid Waste Section (SWS) has reviewed the Operations Plan dated November 20, 2007 for the subject facility. SWS has generated the following comments which must be addressed before the permit may be amended and issued.

1. A site plan and the facility drawings must be submitted showing but not limited to property boundaries, topographic features, contours, access roads and traffic pattern, loading and unloading area, and facility layout.
2. Section 1.1 states the plan is for the proposed facility. Delete "proposed" or replace with "existing". Also verify verbiage through out the operations plan that the plan is not for a proposed facility.
3. Section 2.1 and 6.4 – Correct the name, address and phone number for the Solid Waste Section.

4. Section 4.0 – Is WATER PROTECTION REQUIREMENTS a new section or subsection of 4.0? Also correct the spelling of protection.
5. Section 6.3 – Is local fire protection agency notified about the operation of this facility? State if they are familiar with the facility operations.
6. Provide written contingency plans for equipment breakdown, non-conforming waste delivered to facility, spills, fire, vectors, noise, odors, unusual traffic patterns, long term power outages affecting the leachate pump if any, etc.

7. Provide written documentation of waste screening for at least 1% of the total waste.
8. Sect. 5.0 - Indicate the whole building shall be kept clean, including walls and beams along with floor.
9. Section 7.2 - Indicate that there will be a Certified Transfer Operations Specialist at the site for all the hours the facility is open. Also address safety training for personnel.
10. Editing comments:
 - a. Section 2.1 – Rule .0505(10)(e) should be Rule .0505(10)(e).
 - b. Section 3.1 3rd Paragraph 2nd line – “even” should be “event”.
 - c. Section 3.2 – DEHNR should be DENR.
 - d. Section 3.3 Line 4 – should “tire” be “tare”?
 - e. Section 6.4 – Change “Raleigh Regional Waste Management Specialist” to “Environmental Senior Specialist”.
 - f. Section 7.1 – Change “Division of Solid Waste Management” to “Division of Waste Management”.
 - g. Section 7.1 Last sentence – Correct the sentence to read that the access is prevented.
 - h. Section 7.3 – Change to read that the access roads are already constructed.
