The Solid Waste Section (Section) has reviewed the Structural Fill Facility Permit Application dated March 12, 2009 submitted by the United States Marine Corps. The application meets all of the requirements specified in Section .1700 of the North Carolina Solid Waste Management 15A NCAC 13B Rules. This notification includes the following information as required by Rule .1703:

1. **Nature, Purpose and location of the project:** This project proposes the use of approximately 16,000 cubic yards of coal ash generated from an on-site coal fired heating plant as structural fill to construct an impact berm for the use of live rifle target practice.
