Dear Mr. Bryan:

On Wednesday, May 26, 2010, we had a telephone conversation regarding the permitting of the Abbey Green Recycling Center in Forsyth County. The purpose of this letter is to document the topics we discussed, and provide a completeness determination and technical review of your permit application;

1. I informed you that this project had been assigned to me due to Mr. John Murray's current work load.
2. I informed you that your facility's permit will be entitled *Transfer, Recycle, Resource Recovery and Processing Permit*.
3. A review of your application, drawings and plans indicates you do not intend on having a roof over the Facility. I made you aware of the fact that all water that contacts construction and demolition waste is considered leachate and is wastewater and must be treated as such prior to discharge. Leachate cannot be treated as stormwater. Therefore, please present plans to;
 - a. Contain all leachate received and/or produced on site, and an explanation of how it will be processed.
 - b. Minimize leachate, such as restrictions on operating in wet weather.
4. Include in your Operations Plan an asbestos screening plan, which has been approved by the Division of Epidemiology, otherwise asbestos containing material or material suspected to contain asbestos must not be accepted, this includes all roofing materials.
5. The Operations Plan includes percentages of materials that will be received, for purposes of compliance, equate these to tons or cubic yards, the number should represent the maximum stored on site at any given time.
6. A document review indicates that you have not yet paid your permitting fees, contact Mr. Jeff Skabo at (919) 508-8504 for more information.

7. A document review indicates that you have not responded to the Compliance Review questionnaire dated February 10, 2010. I have attached a copy of that letter and request you to contact Mr. Donald Herndon at (919) 508-8502.
8. You informed me that you intended on receiving equipment in the next few months, receipt of equipment does not necessarily mean construction has commenced, however be careful not to begin construction without a permit. Construction without a permit is violation of North Carolina General Statutes and Administrative Codes.

Finally, I have determined that your permit application is incomplete and until the items listed above have been resolved the permitting of your facility cannot be completed. Should you have any questions regarding this matter you may contact me at (828) 296-4704 or Larry.Frost@ncdenr.gov.

The agency received your application for the new permit to operate. Under N.C.G.S. § 130A-294 (b2)(2) and 295.3 the agency will be conducting a review to determine Abbey Green, Inc.'s past compliance with federal and state laws, regulations, and rules, including permit conditions, for the protection of the environment or conservation of natural resources. If you are a business entity, the compliance review may extend to any other parent, subsidiary, or other affiliate, as well as a partner, a corporate officer or director, or a stockholder holding over 50% of the stock.

For all business entities identified in the organizational charts, please identify those business entities which operated under a previous business name and identify the prior business name.

After review of the organizational charts the agency will request additional follow-up information. Please be advised that under subsection N.C.G.S. § 130A-294(b3), the agency is not required to review the application until you have satisfied the agency that you have met the requirements of subsection (b2).
