On behalf of the Blue Ridge Environmental Defense League and our members in Mecklenburg County, I request that a public hearing be held on the Recycled Fuel Facility Transfer Station, Permit No. P1227, before a permit is issued. The permit is a matter of concern to our members because of its implications for public health related to groundwater and air pollution from solid waste which is proposed for use as fuel in the ReVenture project. Further, the permit presents broad environmental policy concerns not only for residents of the immediate community, but for the State of North Carolina. As you may know, ReVenture's proposed use of municipal solid waste for combustion is not confined to Mecklenburg County. Therefore, a public hearing is necessary for full consideration of the impacts on the environment.

Kindly inform me of any action by the Division before any decisions are made in this matter.
