Notice of public comment period on Draft Permit Number 02-01, to continue operation of the Alexander County Construction and Demolition Debris Landfill (C&DLF), a C&DLF on top of a closed municipal solid waste landfill (MSWLF), pursuant to 15A NCAC 13B .0531, et seq. and 15A NCAC 13B .1600 of the Solid Waste Management Rules is hereby given.

North Carolina Solid Waste Management Rules require that the public be given a 45-day period to comment on this draft permit. The comment period will begin August 20, 2010, and end at 5:00 p.m. on October 4, 2010. Persons wishing to comment on either this permit or the proposed permit conditions should submit their comments in writing to the division contact, Mr. Larry Frost, at the above address. All data submitted by the applicant is available as part of the administrative record and may be reviewed during business hours (9 a.m. - 4 p.m., Monday-Friday, by appointment) at the Division of Waste Management, 2090 US Highway 70, Asheville, North Carolina.

The C&DLF on top of a closed MSWLF is owned and operated by Alexander County, State Road 1620, Taylorsville, Alexander County, North Carolina. The draft permit reflects the request of Alexander County to continue operations for the C&DLF and to operate a groundwater treatment system as the Corrective Action Plan remedy for the closed MSWLF. Impact to groundwater from the closed MSWLF requires the implementation of a corrective action plan. The draft permit contains conditions for the implementation, operation, and assessment of the action plan.

A public hearing has not been scheduled for this permit. Any person interested in a public hearing on this permit should notify the division contact in writing. If sufficient interest exists, a public hearing will be scheduled.
