The application for a MSW Landfill Permit to Operate has been submitted to the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) on your behalf by your consultant Hodges, Harbin, Newberry & Tribble. It was received on January 21, 2011. Your permitting fee was received on February 8, 2011.

In accordance with GS 130A-295.8(e), the Section has reviewed your application and found it to be complete. A determination of completion means that the application includes all required components but does not mean that the required components provide all the information that is required for the Section to make a decision on the application. A copy of the updated facility plan with the groundwater, surface water and methane monitoring systems location needs to be submitted to Brian Wootton in the Raleigh office.

All financial responsibility requirements must be met including 130A-295.2(h), (the owner or operator of a sanitary landfill shall establish financial assurance sufficient to cover a minimum of three million dollars (\$3,000,000) in costs for potential assessment and corrective action at the facility) before a permit may be issued.
