Dear Mr. Green and Wasiela:

Operation Plan Modification for the Use of Petroleum Hydrocarbon Contaminated Soils as Alternate Daily Cover, submitted by ERM NC, P.C. dated June 9, 2009 is approved. In summary, the operations plan is revised to include the sampling and analytical testing protocol from the "Groundwater Section Guidelines for the Investigation and Remediation of Soil and Groundwater, State of North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources Division of Water Quality Groundwater Section, July 2000".

The facility shall maintain records for all solid waste materials accepted as alternative cover material and used as alternate daily cover. The records shall include: the date of receipt, weight of material, general description of the material, identity of the generator and transporter, and county of origin. Such records shall be made available to the Section upon request.

All other requirements of the original approved application submitted by ESP Associates, P.A., dated February 2002 and approved on February 11, 2002 are still applicable.
